Thank you for your letter, dated May 15, 2019, regarding Bee Hollow Road (SR 1008) in Shohola Township, Pike County.

Mr. Gary Pezak, Assistant Maintenance Coordinator in our District Office, field viewed Bee Hollow Road on May 14, 2019. The speed limit on Bee Hollow Road is 25 MPH and it has an average roadway width of 17', as well as an ADT (Average Daily Traffic Count) of 235 vehicles.

Mr. Pezak did note this roadway has several sections that are rough and, also, numerous areas with alligator type cracking. He also noted that the surface of the roadway is not smooth, but was patched last year and there were only two or three minor potholes that he observed.

Bee Hollow Road is scheduled for a surface treatment in 2021, which will consist of a RAP (Recycled Asphalt Pavement) material followed by a sealcoat treatment. Our Maintenance Forces will monitor this roadway and continue to perform pothole patching, as needed, until the surface treatment project is completed.
